## **KRATOM VS. ENERGY DRINKS**

When compared to Kratom it is clear that energy drinks and shots present the REAL threat to the health of American consumers, despite receiving minimal legal and media scrutiny.



- Provides a mild stimulant when used in low dosages
- There have been **ZERO** deaths from Kratom alone
- Heavy consumption can be mildly-habit forming
- According to the Florida Department of Health, there are no pervasive health issues attributed to the ingestion of Kratom products [1]



- Provides a concentrated and acute dose of caffeine
- From 2009-2011, there were 16 deaths related solely to Monster, 5-Hour Energy, and Rockstar.

- In 2011, the AAPCC-NPDS reported the greatest number of caffeine poisoning cases were in children younger than 5 years (1055), followed by individuals aged 20 years or older (938), then ages 13-19 years (428) and ages 6-12 years (83) [3]
